# We Are Saved By Calling on the Name of the Lord

---

“ ‘And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.’” – Acts 2:21

---

# We Are Saved By Christ's Blood

---

Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. - Romans 5:9

---

# We Are Saved By Confession of Faith

---

For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. - Romans 10:10

---

# We Are Saved By Christ's Resurrection

---

For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

– Romans 5:10

“He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.”  
– Mark 16:16


