# The Gospel Account Written by John



- The author was one of the Sons of Zebedee, and a brother of James (Matthew 4:21-22); (Mark 1:19-20)
- Zebedee, his father, was a fisherman of Galilee and; John partnered with his brother (James) along with Andrew and Peter, in the fishing business.
  - Was called to become a disciple of Jesus while mending his nets (Matthew 4:21-22)
- He was a disciple of John the Baptist (John 1:35)
- Named in list of the Apostles (Matthew 10:2-3)
- Acknowledged by scholars to have also authored 1John, 2John, 3John, and Revelation.

# John Records Seven Miracles (Before the Death of Christ)



- Changing water into wine (2:1-11)
- Healing of the nobleman's son (4:46-54)
  - Healing of the lame man (5:1-18)
- Feeding of the five thousand (6:1-14)
  - Walking on water (6:16-21)
  - Healing of the blind man (9:1-12)
- Raising Lazarus from the dead (11:1-46)

# Miracles of Jesus



- **Water Turned to Wine (John 2:1-11)**
  - Displays Jesus' POWER over the elements!
  - John 1:1-3, 6-11
  - 2Peter 3:-13; John 20:30-31

# Miracles of Jesus



- **Healing of Nobleman's Son (John 4:46-54)**
  - Demonstrates Jesus' POWER over distance!
  - What does that mean for you? (Psalm 119:145-152)
