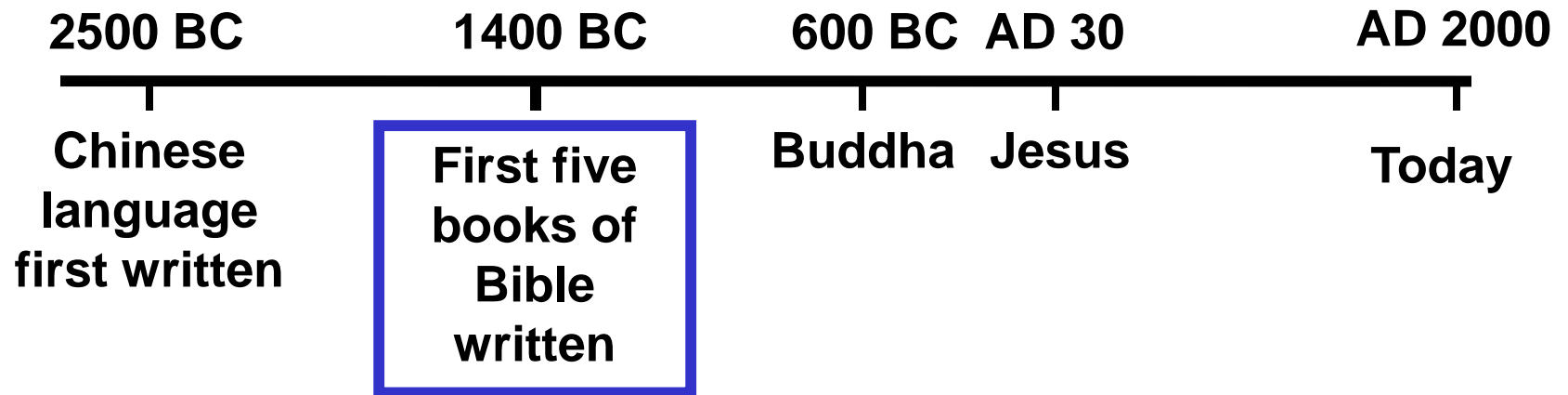

Notice the main points of this story in the Bible

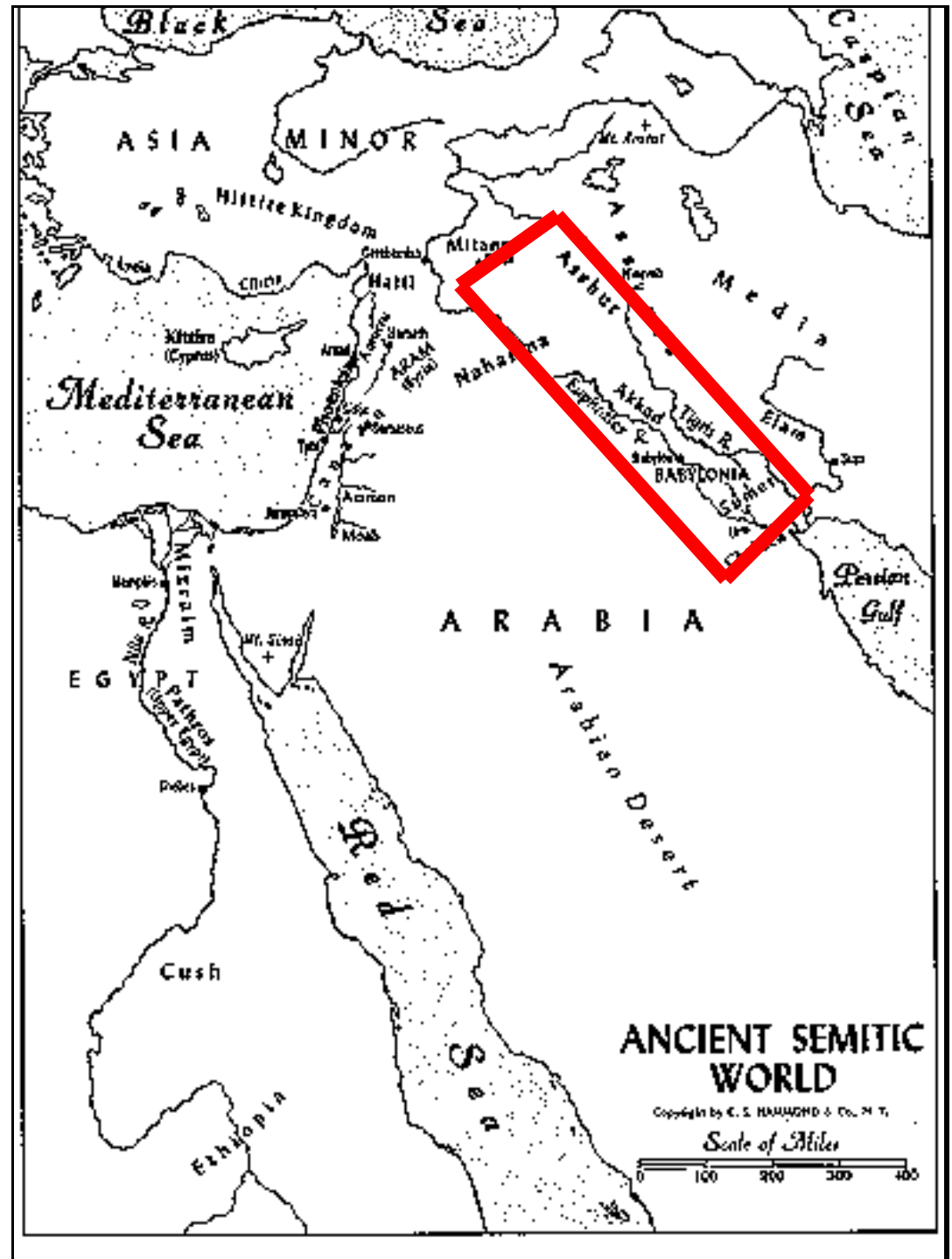
- Took place 5000 years ago

- People were scattered



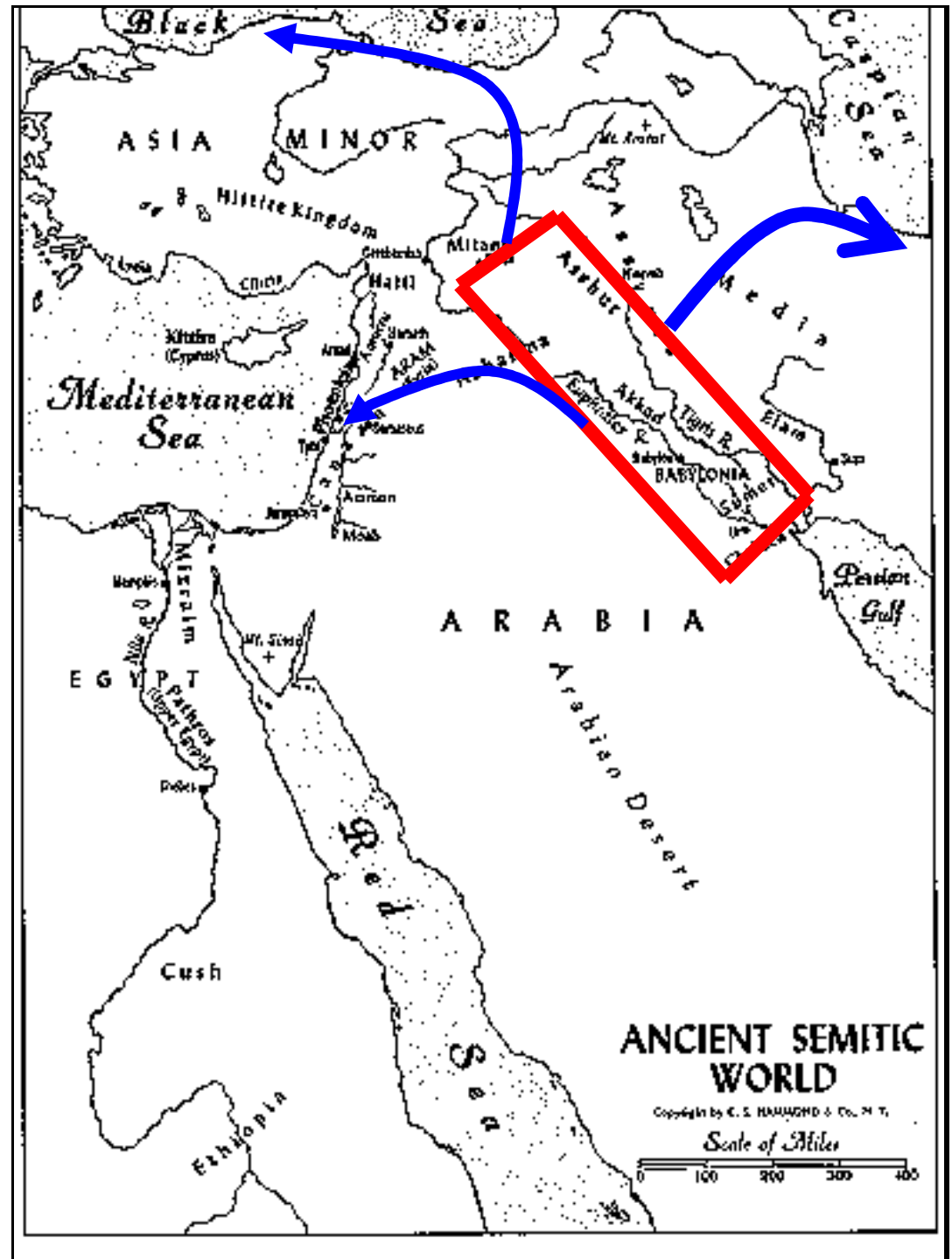
The Scattering of the People

- The Bible tells of them scattering from Babylon

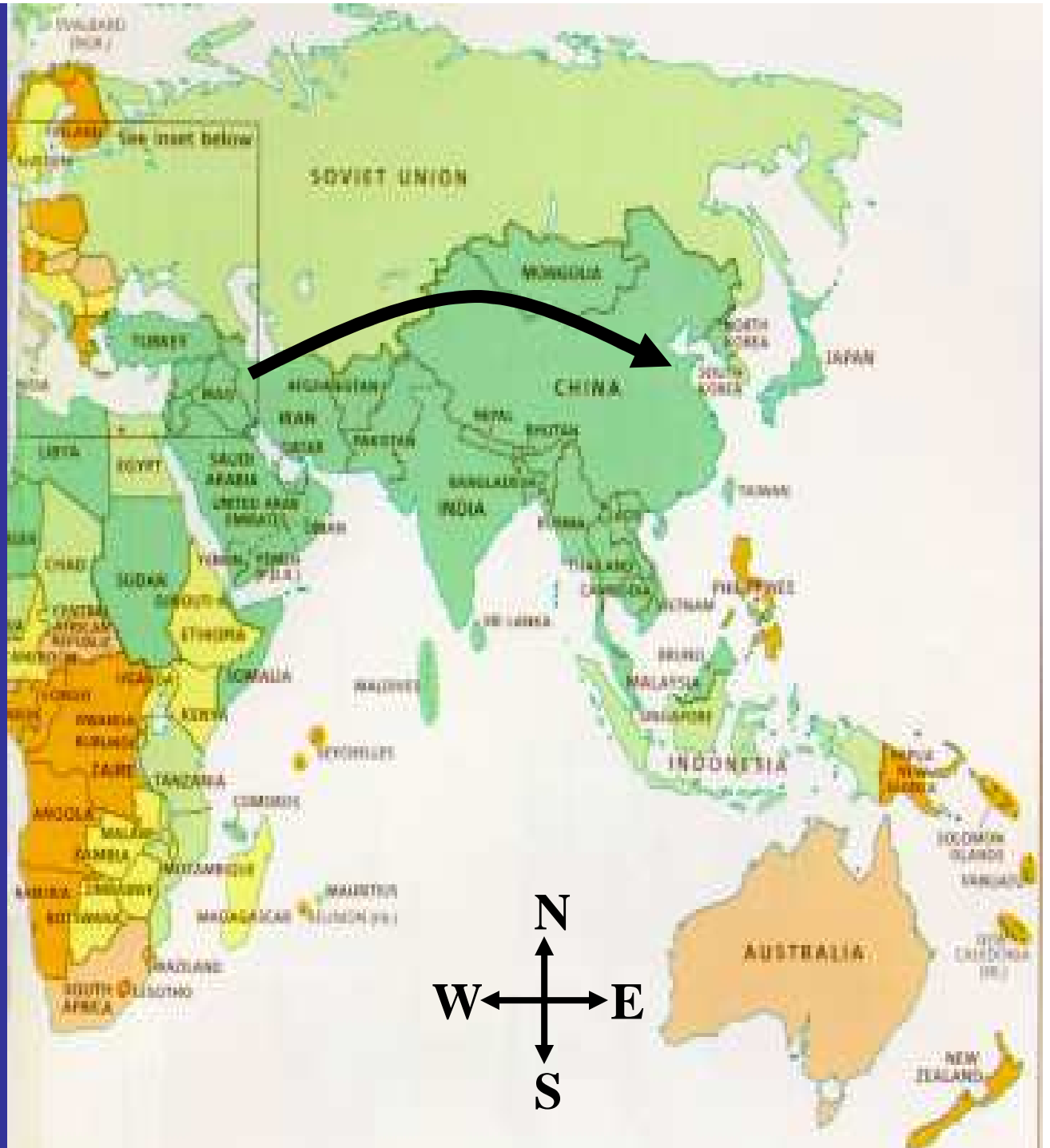
**Location of the

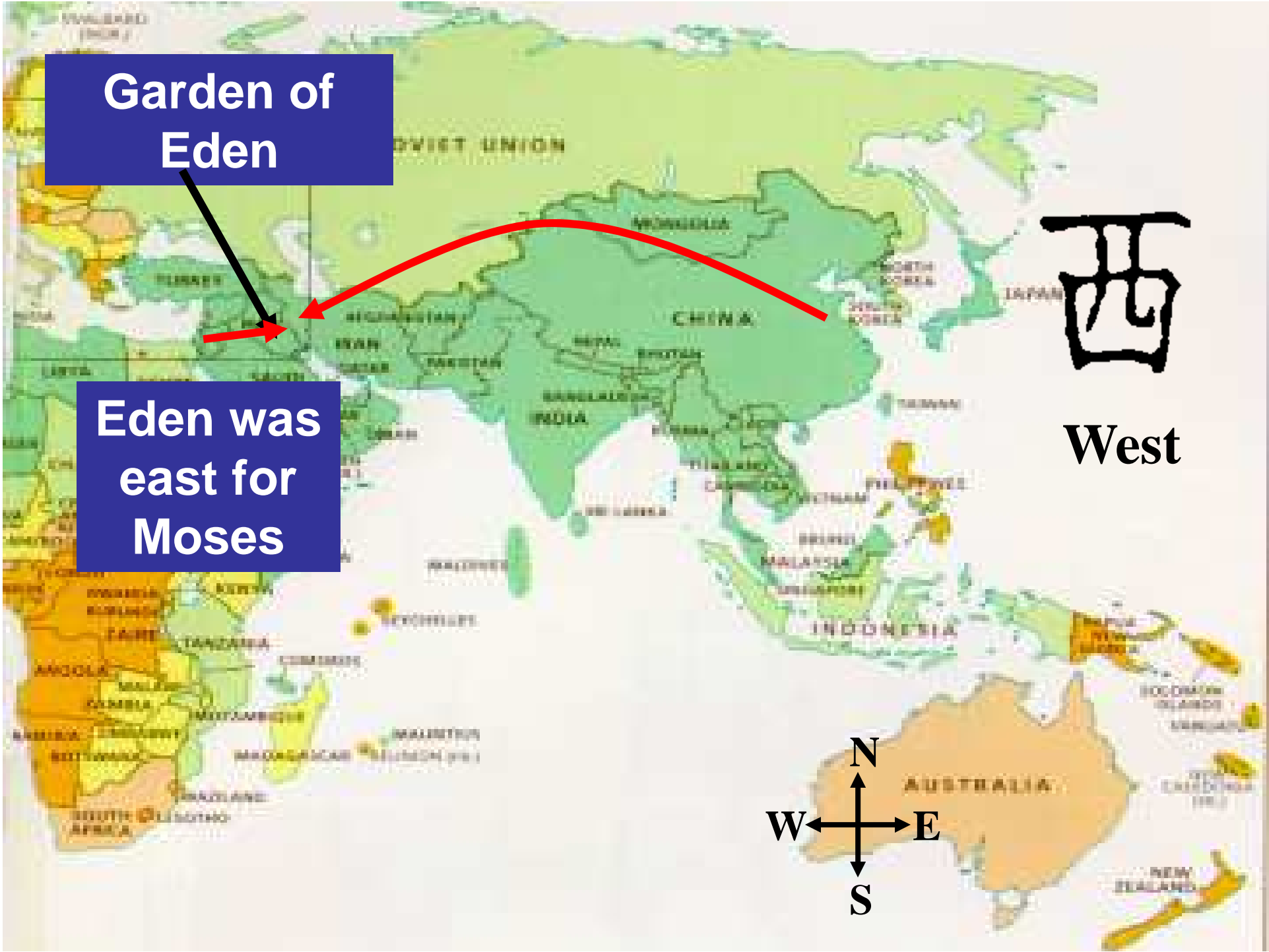
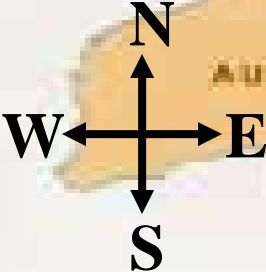

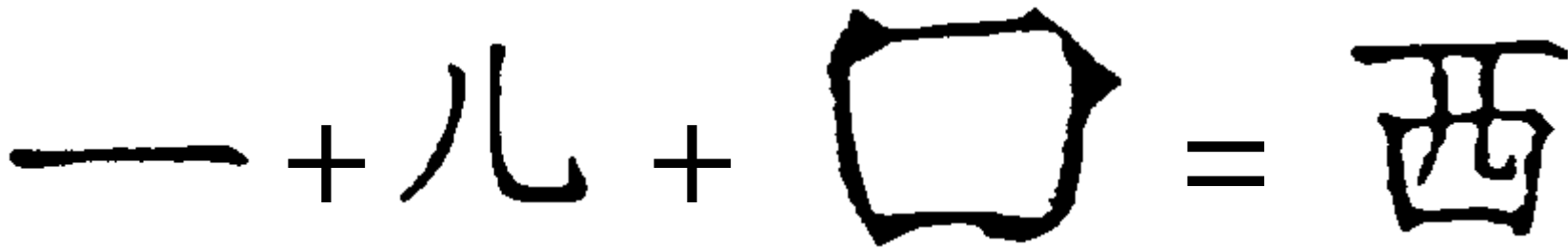
Eden was east for Moses

The Two Trees and Sin

- God gave man a law
- Man was told not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil in the middle of the garden
- God gave man the ability to choose between eating of the tree and not eating of the tree
- Genesis 2:9

And the Lord God made a garden in the east, in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had made. And out of the earth the Lord made every tree to come, delighting the eye and good for food; and in the middle of the garden, the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. (Genesis 2:8-9 BBE)

**And the Lord God gave the man orders, saying, You may freely take of the fruit of every tree of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you may not take; for on the day when you take of it, death will certainly come to you.

Man was forbidden to eat one of the two trees -- if he ate the forbidden tree the other would be taken from him also.

The Woman and the Forbidden Fruit

When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate. 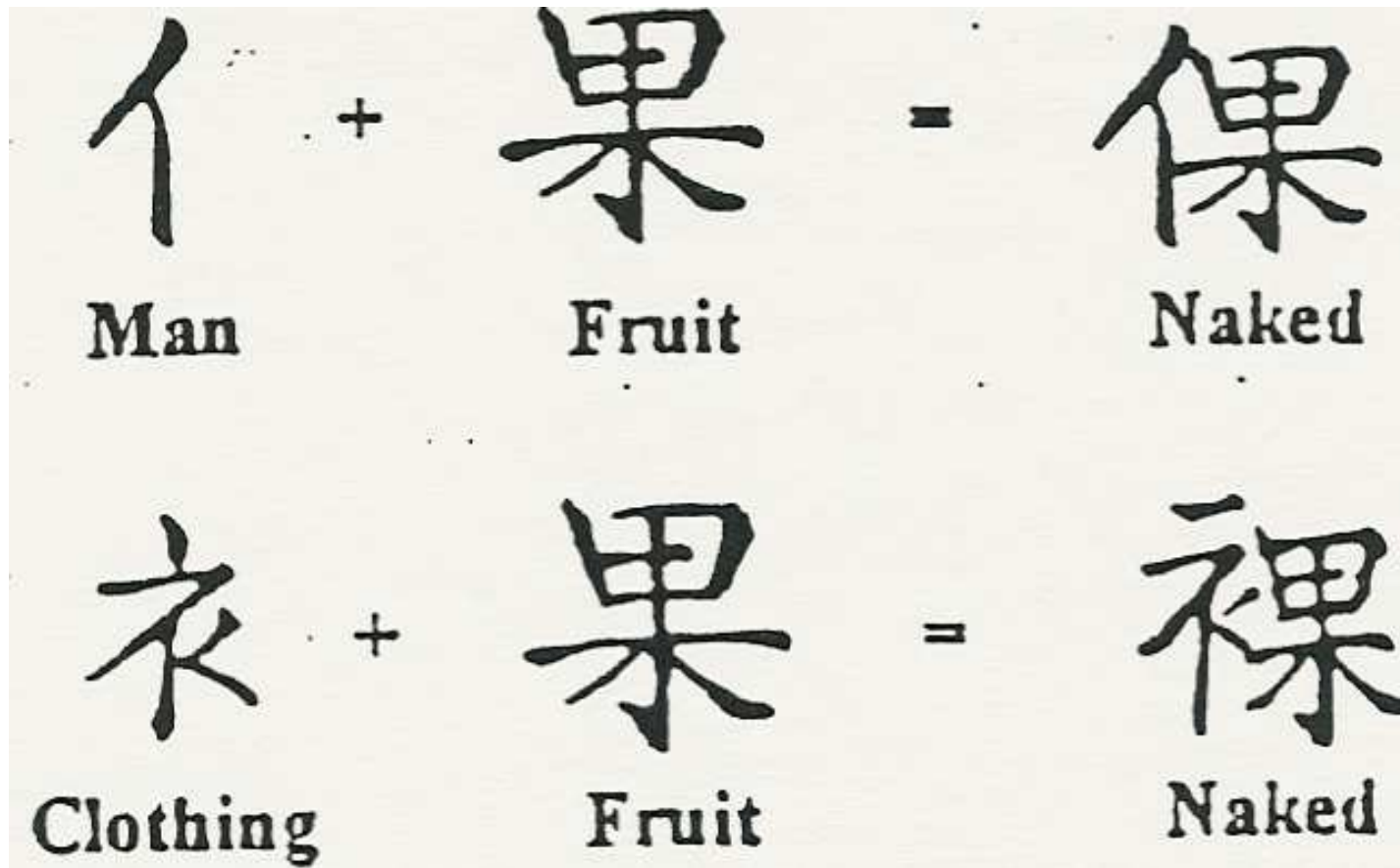

The First Murder

- Adam and Eve's sons were named Cain and Abel
- Cain, the older son, killed Abel the younger son
- Genesis 4:1-2, 8

The First Murder

And the man had come with his wife, and she became with child and gave birth to a son. And she said, I have got a man from the Lord. And she gave birth to another son, but Cain was the older brother. Cain was a farmer, and he brought an offering of the fruits of the soil to the Lord. And Abel was a shepherd of the young lambs of his flock, and he brought an offering of the young lambs to the Lord. The Flood

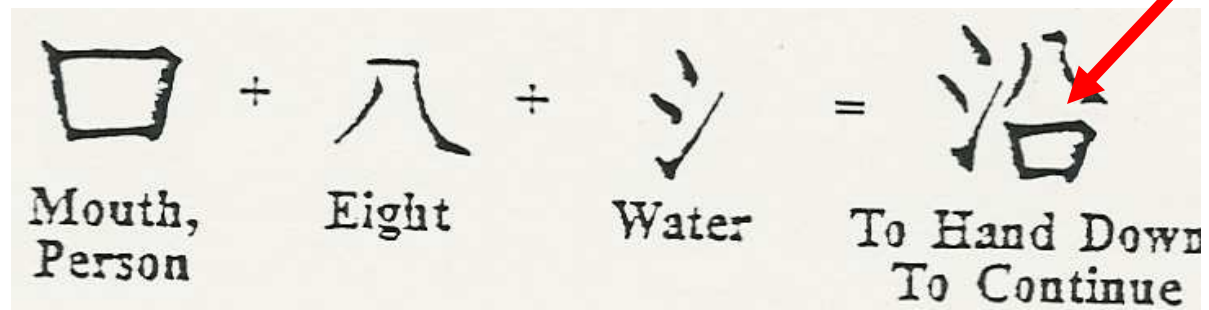
